

S.T.A.R.S. 2020 Summer Camp Guidelines Addendum

COVID – 19

The City of Fort Myers S.T.A.R.S. Summer Program will provide a safe, clean, and healthy environment for children to learn, play and interact. Activities will include exercise, games, enrichment, and academic support. We will strictly follow CDC, local, state and national health and safety regulations and guidelines.

The health and safety of our families continues to be our top priority. We are adhering to the CDC's recommendations for preparedness and taking additional steps as needed such as daily health screenings at check in, smaller group sizes, activities that do not require close physical contact, limited shared equipment and changes to dining procedures. In addition to our required first aid, CPR and child wellness training, our staff will be well versed with disinfection best practices, social distancing strategies and active parent communication.



CAMP HOURS

Summer Camp hours have been shortened to accommodate the additional restrictions for COVID-19. The new hours are Monday-Friday 8:30am-5:30pm. ***Participants cannot be dropped off after 9:00am, and must be picked up by 5:45pm.***

MASKS

CDC issued guidance around the use of mask. The S.T.A.R.S. Summer program will issue each student a mask. We ask that Parents discuss the correct way to safely wear a mask and wash it daily.

FILED TRIPS

All non-City venue field trips have been canceled. Unfortunately, we must reduce the sizes of each group. We will not be able to adequately meet social distancing guidelines while busing participants to those locations. However, we will add special activities for the smaller groups at other City locations, such as the Skatium, Billy Bowlegs Park and Riverside Community Center.

FACILITY ACCESS CONTROL

As part of our strategy to limit the spread of coronavirus, the building will be closed to the general public during camp hours. Signs will be posted at the entry of the facility that clearly states only essential personnel will be admitted into the program space.

PAYMENTS/ LUNCH

STARS will be using a contactless payment system (NO CASH). All payments due for Summer Camp must be done via phone (239) 321-7545 prompt #5. STARS is a participant in the School District of Lee County, Summer Feeding Program that provides a free lunch each day. Students are allowed to bring a lunch box to camp. In addition, STARS will offer a lunch menu for purchase. Purchasing a lunch is optional. *Parents cannot drop off/deliver lunch during a campers lunch time.* Parents are to review the weekly lunch menu and prepay for lunch and snacks accordingly. **Each morning a staff member will be in parent drop off to take lunch or snack payments only.**



DROP OFF & PICK UP

A new pick up and drop off procedure will be strictly enforced. (SEE MAP FOR ENTRY & EXIT AREA) Parents must follow designated drive up areas to drop off and pick up participants. Sign in and sign out procedures should be handled in a way that minimizes transmission (only those assigned a pin number will be allowed to pick up participants).

Morning Drop off 8:15am- 9:00am

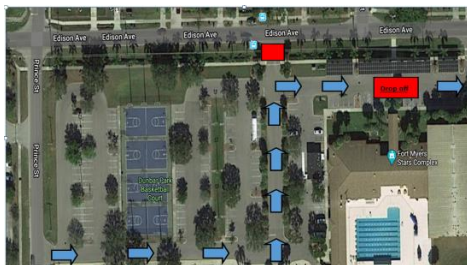
Afternoon Pick Up- 4:45pm-5:30pm

Participants may not be dropped off any time after 9:00am.

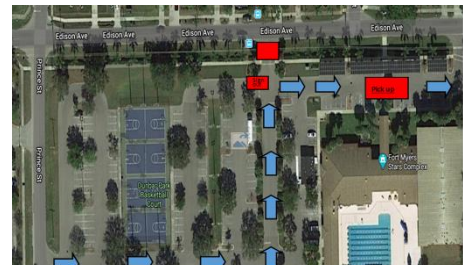
Parents may pick their child up prior to 4:45pm with advance notice. Parents should call the program (239) 321-7545 to let know of their arrival and the children will be escorted in/out of the building. Once the pickup period begins, participants must follow pickup rules.

Pick Up



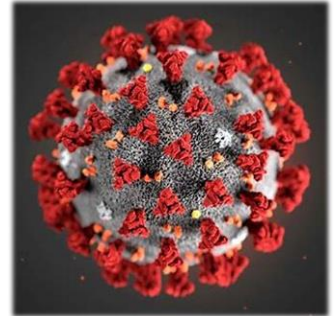
Sick Child

STARS will conduct a daily health check for all staff and children entering the facility. Any child or adult that is experiencing signs or symptoms of illness should stay at home. A no-touch digital thermometer will be used to obtain temperature readings. In addition, each Monday, a questionnaire must be complete prior to drop off.

Screening questions:

Have you tested positive for COVID-19?

- Have you or anyone in your household been tested for COVID-19?
- Do you or anyone in your household think they could have COVID-19?
- Do you or anyone in your household (including children) have these symptoms or have been in close contact with anyone with these symptoms?
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Sore throat
 - Diarrhea



If any of the above answers are yes, entry to the program should be denied.

If any individual is discovered with signs or symptoms while at the program, they will be sent home as soon as possible. A participant will not be able to return to camp until cleared through a medical professional.

Further, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the City, its public officials, its officers, directors, agents, and employees from any and all liabilities, damages, losses and costs, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees and court costs, such legal expenses to include costs incurred in establishing indemnification and other rights agreed to in this paragraph, to persons or property, resulting from myself or my child or ward participating in the City of Fort Myers STARS Program. The City of Fort Myers STARS Program reserves the right to deny registration to any participant. The participant must adhere to all City and Fort Myers STARS Program policies.

I authorize medical treatment and related transportation for myself, child or ward, at my cost, if the need arises.

This Agreement shall be enforced only within a state court of competent jurisdiction within Lee County, Florida, or such federal courts as they have jurisdiction over Lee County, Florida. This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed under the laws of the State of Florida without reference to the conflict of laws principles of such jurisdiction.

I certify that I am 18 years of age or older or that I am entering into this Agreement as the Parent or Legal Guardian for a minor that is under 18 years of age and that I also have authority to do so on behalf of any other parent or legal guardian of the child or ward.
