The City of Fort Myers in our continuing effort to enhance citizen participation would like to invite citizens to participate in the 5-Day comment period from November 18, 2020 to November 23, 2020 on the City's Community Block Grant Programs (CDBG) Five Year Consolidated Plan 2020-2024, First Program Year Annual Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2020-2021, Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) 2020-2024, Limited English Proficiency (LEP) 2020-2024. The anticipated funding for Year-One is \$641,570 The funds are used to develop stronger communities by providing decent housing, creating suitable living environments, and expanding economic opportunities, to low- to moderate income persons that reside within the City limits.

A PUBLIC HEARING will be held in the Council Chambers at Oscar M. Corbin, Jr. City Hall, 2200 Second Street, Fort Myers, Florida, on Monday, December 7, 2020, on or about 5:15 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as can be heard, to consider public input on the plans.

This publication requires a 5-day notice period under Federal Regulations at 24 CFR 91.105 and Federal Regulations waivers due to the COVID-19 crisis. On March 27, 2020, the United States Congress passed The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (H.R. 748).
